

# Warrior Row Selection Criteria

## WARRIOR ROW ELIGIBILITY

1. Full-time traditional day students
2. Seniors (90 or more credit hours) and juniors (60-89 credit hours)
  - a. Exception to be made for sophomores (30-59 credit hours) applying with upper classmen
  - b. Transfers must have completed one semester at Indiana Tech before being eligible; i.e., if a student is applying for the following academic year (fall of 2010) and they transferred the previous academic year (spring of 2010), they **would** be eligible
3. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
  - a. Good outstanding academic record
    - i. If a student has been placed on academic probation they must have proof of improved performance
4. No single person may apply; students must be a part of a group
5. No coed rooms will be allowed
  - a. Although men and women will both be housed in the unit, there will be no mixed gender groups placed in room

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- Credit hours completed
- Cumulative GPA
- Active participation in extra-curricular activities within current academic year
  - \*Advisors/coaches will be required to sign and verify participation

### AVAILABILITY

- TWO 6-PERSON ROOMS
- FOUR 4-PERSON ROOMS
- ONE 5-PERSON ROOM (HANDICAP ACCESSIBLE)

Points will be given to each student based on the criteria above. These points will then be totaled for each individual applying for the rooms. After all points are totaled for the individuals, a combined total for the \*group will be found.

\*Group: The students requesting to room with one another

Points will be added for EACH extra-curricular activity a student participates in within CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR; i.e., if Jane plays softball (3), is a tutor (5) and actively participates in Student Board (3) she would have a total of 11 points.

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. Students must complete Warrior Row applications.
  - a. Each person requesting to live within the room will need to fill out his or her own application.
2. After the applications are submitted, the housing selection committee will score each group requesting a room.
3. The groups with the highest point totals will have first chance to select their rooms.
  - a. The groups will be separated by the room size they are requesting.
  - b. If a group includes an individual with a disability the group will be given priority for the handicap accessible room
4. Once the group is selected and contacted they will have 24 hours to confirm acceptance and 36 hours to submit a housing deposit if they have not done so in prior years.
5. If a confirmation is not received in the allotted time, Indiana Tech will assume that the students reject the offer and the next group will be contacted.
