Program Overview

Earning an associate degree in the accounting program at Ivy Tech Community College gives you an excellent start toward a bachelor's degree at Indiana Tech. Through a partnership between the two institutions, you can progress smoothly from one program to the next.

The Ivy Tech associate degree will prepare you for entry-level jobs such as accounting assistant or bookkeeper. The bachelor's degree program at Indiana Tech allows you to build on your Ivy Tech associate degree with more advanced study of accounting. Almost all of your courses will be accepted for transfer credit and fulfill requirements toward a bachelor's degree in accounting.

The bachelor's degree provides you with an in-depth knowledge of accounting, auditing, and tax. Upon graduation, you'll be prepared for senior level accounting jobs that include financial accounting activities, cost accounting, auditing, and tax work.

On the other side of this information sheet, you will see an overview of how your Ivy Tech credits will transfer into the Indiana Tech bachelor's degree program.

If you wish to pursue an accounting education even further, Indiana Tech offers an accounting concentration in the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program. In this program, the course work includes Becker Review courses, which prepare graduate students for the CPA exam.
