Program Overview

Earning an associate degree in the human services program at Ivy Tech Community College gives you an excellent start toward a bachelor’s degree at Indiana Tech. Through a partnership between the two institutions, you can progress smoothly from one program to the next.

The Ivy Tech associate degree will prepare you for entry-level positions in case management, community corrections, counseling, and social services. 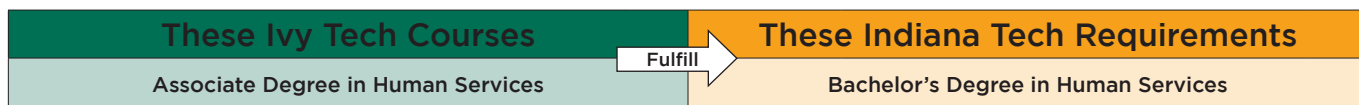
